

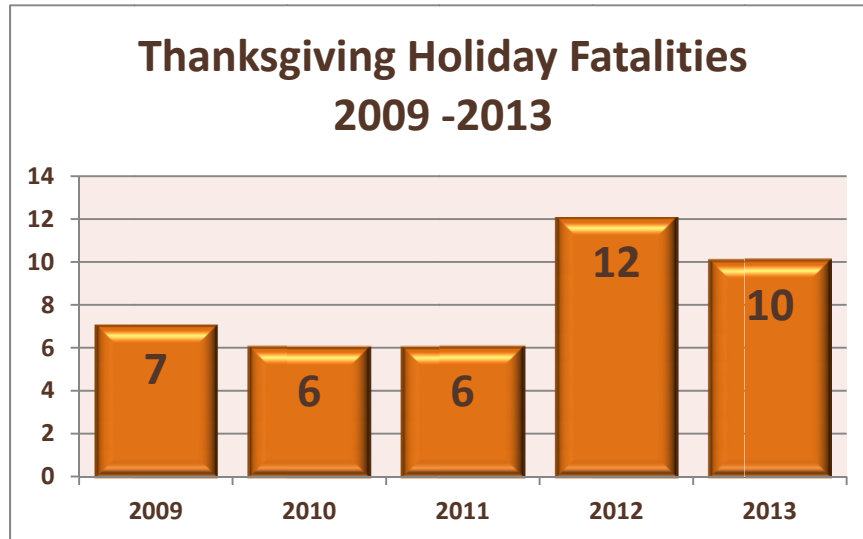

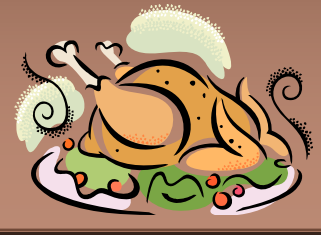

Crashes, Fatalities & Injuries

The Thanksgiving Holiday period in 2013 was a total of 102 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, November 27 and ended at midnight on Sunday, December 1. During this time period there were 10 persons killed in eight fatal crashes. Five of the 10 fatalities occurred in alcohol-related crashes.

Fatalities & Safety Equipment

Of the 10 fatalities, nine were occupants in a passenger vehicle/pickup truck and one was a bicyclist. Two of the vehicle occupant fatalities were unrestrained and restraint use was unknown for one occupant.
