Crashes & Fatalities

The 2016 Independence Day Holiday was a total of 78 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Friday, July 1 and ended at midnight on Monday, July 4. During this time period, four persons were killed in three fatal crashes. All four of the fatalities occurred in alcohol/drug-related crashes.

Two fatalities were occupants of a passenger vehicle, one was the driver of a pickup truck, and one was a passenger on the back of a motorcycle.

Of the three occupants of a passenger vehicle/pickup truck, the driver of the pickup truck was unrestrained, and restraint use for two occupants was unknown. Helmet use for the motorcycle passenger is unknown.
