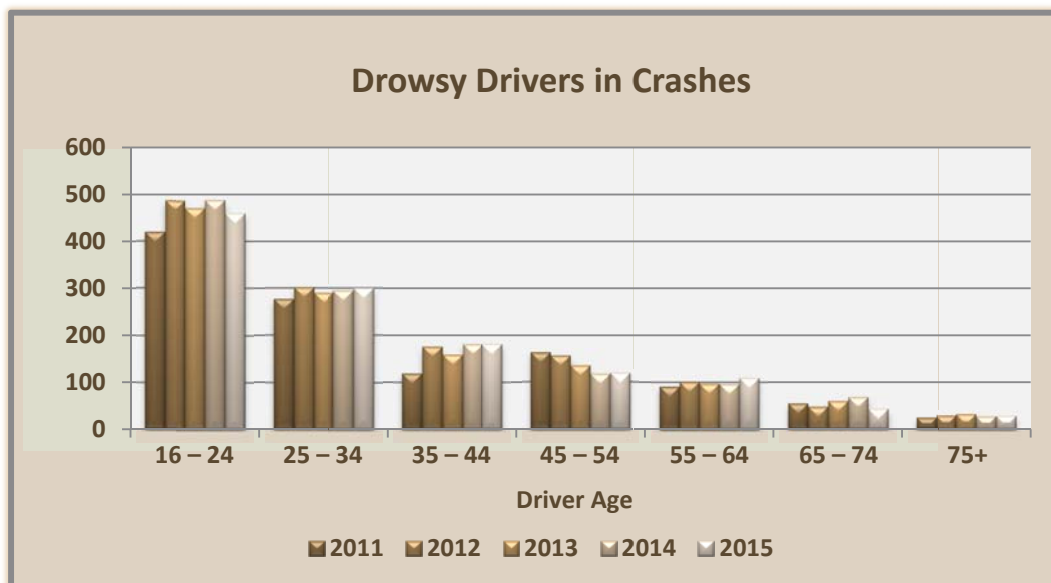

- Oklahoma crash reports are completed by law enforcement officers at the scene of a crash where the officer indicates the condition of the drivers involved in a crash.
- The two choices used for this report are:
 - Very tired
 - Sleepy
- In 2011, 12 fatal crashes, 584 injury crashes and 555 non-injury crashes involved a drowsy driver.
- In 2012, 18 fatal crashes, 653 injury crashes and 629 non-injury crashes involved a drowsy driver.
- In 2013, 15 fatal crashes, 595 injury crashes and 634 non-injury crashes involved a drowsy driver.
- In 2014, 14 fatal crashes, 614 injury crashes and 652 non-injury crashes involved a drowsy driver.
- In 2015, 14 fatal crashes, 539 injury crashes and 687 non-injury crashes involved a driver distracted by an electronic device.
