Crashes, Fatalities & Injuries

The Christmas Holiday period in 2009 was a total of 78 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Thursday, December 24 and ended at midnight on Sunday, December 27. During this time period there were nine persons killed in seven fatal crashes. One of the nine fatalities occurred in an alcohol-related crash.

Fatalities & Safety Equipment

Of the nine fatalities, eight were occupants in a passenger vehicle/pickup truck and one was a pedestrian. Four of the vehicle occupant fatalities were unrestrained.
