Crashes, Fatalities & Injuries

The New Year Holiday period in 2009 was a total of 78 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Thursday, December 31, 2009 and ended at midnight on Sunday, January 3, 2010. During this time period there were five persons killed in four fatal crashes. Three of the five fatalities occurred in alcohol-related crashes.

Fatalities & Safety Equipment

All five fatalities were occupants in a passenger vehicle/pickup truck. None of the vehicle occupant fatalities were restrained.
