Crashes & Fatalities

The Christmas Holiday period for 2004 was a total of 54 hours which began at 6 p.m. on December 24, 2004 and ended at midnight on December 26, 2004.

During this time period, there were two persons killed in two fatal crashes.

Fatalities & Safety Equipment

There were two fatalities in two fatal crashes during the Christmas Holiday in 2004 where one driver in a passenger vehicle was killed and one passenger in a pickup truck was killed. Both fatalities were using safety equipment.

Driver Age & Gender

The two drivers involved in fatal crashes ranged in age from 31 to 40. One driver was female and the other was male.

Causes

Both fatal crashes were caused by Unsafe Speed.

Number of Vehicles Involved

Both fatal crashes involved only one vehicle.
