Crashes, Fatalities & Injuries

The Christmas Holiday period in 2010 was a total of 78 hours that began at 6 p.m. on Thursday, December 23 and ended at midnight on Sunday, December 26. During this time period, six persons were killed in five fatal crashes. Two of the fatalities occurred in one alcohol-related crash.

Fatalities & Restraints

The six persons killed were occupants of a passenger vehicle or pickup truck. Four of the vehicle occupant fatalities were unrestrained.
