Crashes, Fatalities & Injuries

The Christmas Holiday period in 2011 was a total of 78 hours that began at 6 p.m. on Friday, December 23 and ended at midnight on Monday, December 26. During this time period, four persons were killed in three fatal crashes. Three of the fatalities occurred in two alcohol-related crashes.

Fatalities & Restraints

Of the four fatalities, three were occupants of a passenger vehicle or pickup truck. One of the vehicle occupant fatalities was unrestrained.
