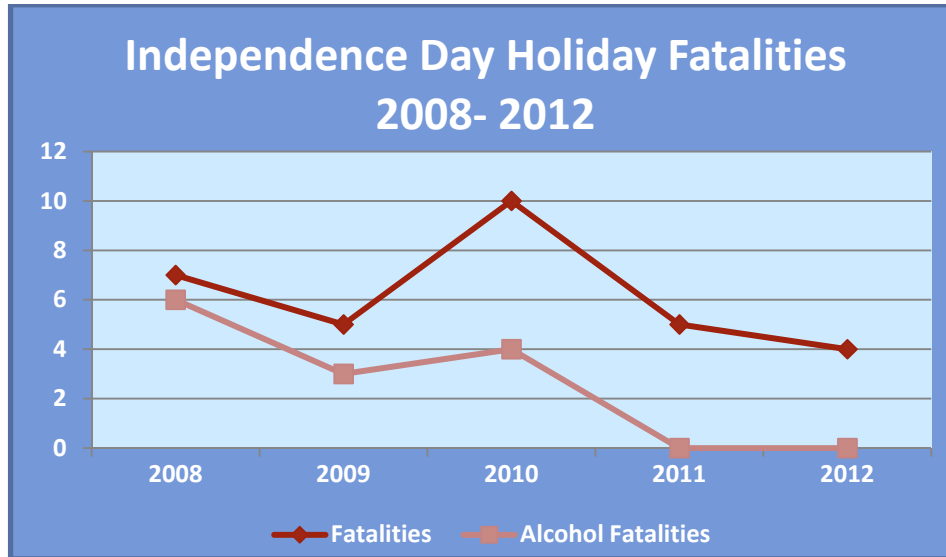

▶ Fatalities decreased from five in 2011 to four in 2012

▶ No alcohol-related fatalities were reported



Crashes & Fatalities

The 2012 Independence Day Holiday was a total of 30 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Tuesday, July 3 and ended at midnight on Wednesday, July 4. During this time period, there were four persons killed in three fatal crashes.

All four fatalities were occupants of passenger vehicles.



Restraint Use Among Fatalities

All four fatalities were occupants of passenger vehicles and all four were using restraints.
