- ▶ Fatalities increased from four in 2012 to 12 in 2013
- ▶ Alcohol-related fatalities increased from two in 2012 to three in 2013



### Crashes & Fatalities

The 2013 Labor Day Holiday was a total of 78 hours, which began at 6 p.m. on Friday, August 30 and ended at midnight on Monday, September 2. During this time period, 12 persons were killed in 12 fatal crashes. Three of the 12 fatalities occurred in alcohol-related crashes.



### Restraint Use Among Fatalities

One driver fatality was an occupant of a pickup truck and unrestrained. Three motorcyclist fatalities were not wearing a helmet.
