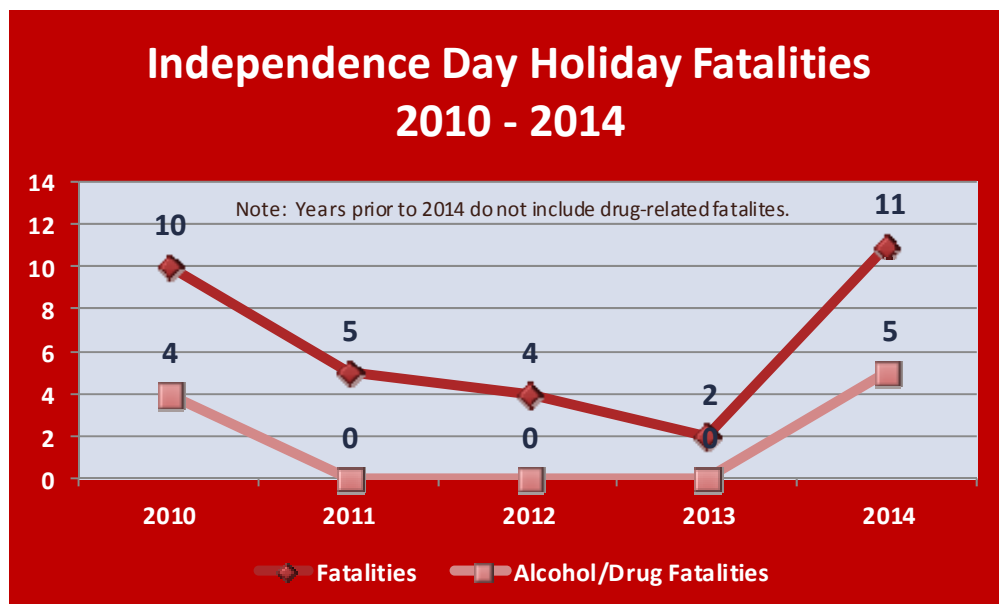

Crashes & Fatalities

The 2014 Independence Day Holiday was a total of 78 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Thursday, July 3 and ended at midnight on Sunday, July 6. During this time period, 11 persons were killed in seven fatal crashes. Five of the 11 fatalities occurred in alcohol/drug-related crashes.

Four fatalities were occupants of a passenger vehicle, three were occupants of a pickup truck, two were occupants of a single unit truck and two were motorcyclists.

All seven of the occupants of a passenger vehicle/pickup truck were unrestrained. Both occupants of the single unit truck were unrestrained and both of the motorcyclists were not wearing a helmet.
