### Crashes & Fatalities

The 2016 Memorial Day holiday was a total of 78 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Friday, May 27 and ended at midnight on Monday, May 30. During this time period, nine persons were killed in six fatal crashes. Two of the ten fatalities occurred in alcohol/drug-related crashes.

Three fatalities were occupants of a passenger vehicle, three were occupants of a pickup truck, two were motorcyclists, and one was a pedestrian on a skateboard.

Of the six occupants of a passenger vehicle/pickup truck, two were unrestrained. This includes one person riding in the open back of a pickup truck. Both of the motorcyclists were unhelmeted.
