

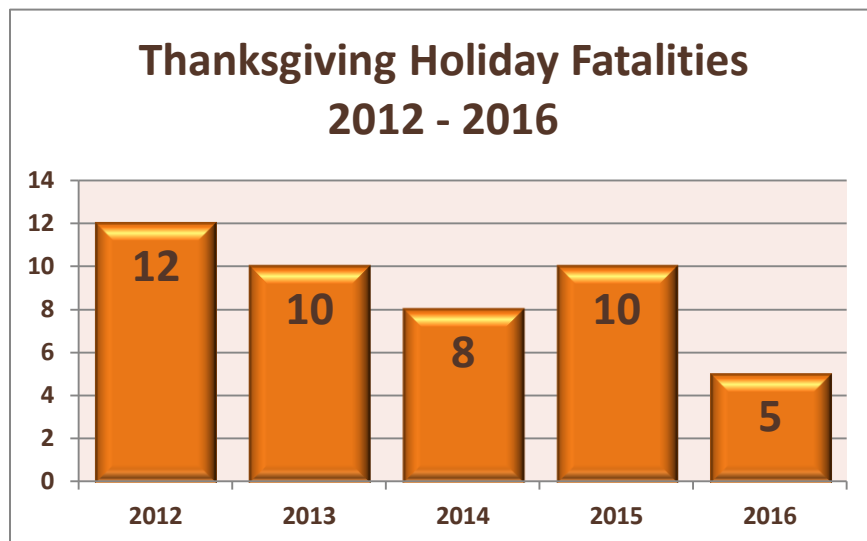

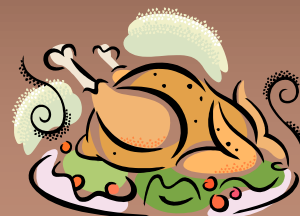

Crashes, Fatalities & Injuries

The Thanksgiving Holiday period in 2016 was a total of 102 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, November 23 and ended at midnight on Sunday, November 27. During this time period, there were five persons killed in five fatal crashes. One of the five fatalities occurred in an alcohol-related crash. There were no drug-related fatalities over the holiday weekend.

Fatalities & Safety Equipment

Of the five fatalities, two were occupants in a passenger vehicle/pickup truck and three were pedestrians. One of the vehicle occupant fatalities, a passenger, was unrestrained. The other, a driver, was restrained.
