### Crashes, Fatalities & Injuries

The Independence Day Holiday period for 2007 was a total of 30 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Tuesday July 3 and ended at midnight on Wednesday, July 4. During this time period, two persons were killed in two fatal crashes. One of the two fatalities occurred in an Alcohol/Drug-Related crash.

### Fatalities and Safety Equipment Use

One fatality was a driver and the other fatality was a passenger. Neither fatality was using safety restraints.
