Crashes and Fatalities

The Christmas Holiday period for 2003 was a total of 30 hours which began at 6 p.m. on December 24, 2003 and ended at midnight on December 25, 2003.

During this time period, there were two persons killed in two fatal crashes.

Fatalities & Safety Equipment

There were two fatalities in two fatal crashes during the Christmas Holiday in 2003 where one driver in a passenger vehicle was killed and one passenger in a passenger vehicle was killed. Both fatalities were not using safety equipment.

Driver Age & Gender

The three drivers involved in fatal crashes ranged in age from 20 to 61. All three drivers were female.

Causes

One fatal crash was caused by a sleepy driver and the other was caused by other improper/act movement.

Number of Vehicles Involved

One fatal crash involved one vehicle and the other involved two vehicles.
