## Crashes, Fatalities & Injuries

The Thanksgiving Holiday period in 2012 was a total of 102 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, November 21 and ended at midnight on Sunday, November 25. During this time period there were 12 persons killed in nine fatal crashes. Four of the 12 fatalities occurred in an alcohol-related crash.



## Fatalities & Safety Equipment

Of the 12 fatalities, nine were occupants in a passenger vehicle/pickup truck and three were motorcyclists. Five of the vehicle occupant fatalities were unrestrained.

Two motorcyclist fatalities were not wearing a safety helmet and helmet use was unknown for one motorcyclist.
